# General Exhibitor notes

- 1. Meeting set up starts at 5am on Friday, Dec 4, 2026
- 2. Tables can be attended during all sessions and breaks on Friday and Saturday
- 3. Sponsors may neither state nor imply endorsement by the GNYAP- except
- 4. when the GNYAP Council provides specific written prior approval.
- 5. The GNYAP has sole discretion to determine all aspects of program, including,
- 6. but not limited to speakers, topics, session location, etc.
- 7. Materials used during the event may not be reproduced without the presenter's
- 8. express permission
- 9. The GNYAP will not be responsible for any equipment/materials left after the
- 10. close of the Meeting.
- 11. Displays should not exceed 8 feet in height. Any exhibit that interferes with
- 12. other exhibitors, extends beyond the designated booth space, or is deemed
- 13. objectionable by the GNYAP must be immediately modified or removed by the exhibitor.
- 14. All exhibit equipment, materials and promotional activities must be
- 15. located within the confines of the booth or table.
- 16. Affixing anything to exhibit pipe and drape and/or facility structure is
- 17. prohibited. All flammable materials are prohibited.
- 18. Devices that project sound may be played only at a low level that does not
- 19. interfere with other exhibitors in any way. Music and objectionable lighting effects are prohibited.
- 20. Exhibitors may take orders, but not sell and deliver merchandise.
- 21. All installation and dismantling of booths must occur only during designated
- 22. time periods. All booths must remain intact until close of the show and no exhibit additions or removals are allowed during show hours. All booths must be staffed during show hours.
- 23. Promotional materials must be of a professional nature and any give-away items are subject to approval by the GNYAP.
- 24. Exhibitor is solely responsible for compliance with local, city, and federal
- 25. ordinances and regulations regarding fire, safety, and health regulations. Exhibitor will also comply with all union and facility regulations and/or policies.
- 26. Exhibitor is solely responsible and liable for losses, damages, and claims arising
- 27. out of exhibitor's activities on the Jazz at Lincoln Center (JALC) premises and shall indemnify, defend and hold harmless the JALC and GNYAP, their respective officers, directors, servants, agents and employees from any and all such losses, damages, and claims
- 28. Exhibitor is solely liable for any damage resulting from the exhibitor's action and/or negligence.



# General Exhibitor notes

- 29. All exhibitors must wear name badges and ribbons for exhibit hall admission.
- 30. Exhibitors will be admitted to the exhibit hall ½ hour before show opening each
- 31. day. All exhibitors and attendees will be required to leave the floor within ½hour after the show closes each day unless prior arrangements are made with the GNYAP.
- 32. GNYAP will accept no deliveries of displays or merchandise. All shipping
- 33. transactions should be conducted through the official show decorator, Freeman Decorating Company. All empty containers must be stored with the show decorator.
- There is no storage area at the JALC. GNYAP assumes no responsibility for exhibit storage.
- 34. GNYAP reserves the sole right to promulgate, interpret, amend and enforce all rules and regulations, and to alter the exhibit floor plan and schedule in the best interest of the meeting participants, exhibition and the exhibitors. All matters not addressed in these rules and regulations are subject to the discretion of the GNYAP.
- 35. Exhibitor is responsible for safeguarding its own property at all times. While general security will be provided during the show, neither the JALC nor GNYAP guarantees the prevention of occurrences which may result in loss or damage. Neither the JALC nor GNYAP maintains insurance covering exhibitor's property. It is the sole responsibility of exhibitor to obtain such insurance. Should events beyond the control of the JALC and GNYAP (including but not limited to acts of God, labor disputes, civil disturbances, acts of terrorism, curtailment of transportation, etc.) materially affect either party's ability to perform, this contract shall be terminated without prejudice.
- 36. Sharing or subletting booth/table space is prohibited
- 37. The actual costs for pipe and drape and/or any additional charges incurred will be billed through Freeman Decorating Company following the meeting.
- 38. Sponsors agree to accept booth/table for a "Commercial Exhibit" with no guarantee of provision for electricity.

## Our History

The Greater New York Academy of Prosthodontics was formally organized on December 6, 1954 in New York City, to meet the needs of dentists located in the eastern part of the United States who were interested in the practice of prosthodontics and its related sciences. The Academy's original aim was to foster a better understanding among the various specialty groups in dentistry, and to promote and stimulate further research in prosthodontics and its related fields. The organization has grown from its original thirteen charter members to 218 at present. Membership is by invitation, and is not confined to the New York area.
